David Callow has been involved in the TiO₂ pigment industry since 1966, principally in the UK, South Africa and Germany. He became TZMI's European Associate in September 2004.

David graduated from Cambridge University in 1966 with an honours degree in Natural Sciences (Chemistry focused) and Economics, and joined the TiO₂ pigment industry in that year.

David held a variety of marketing roles with Tioxide, eventually becoming General Manager, Marketing for Tioxide Europe. From 1995 until 1998, he was Managing Director, Tioxide Southern Africa, responsible for the then joint venture sulfate process operation at a time of great change in South Africa. From 1998 to 2002, he was Managing Director, Europe for Kerr-McGee Chemical, located first in Germany and then Switzerland. During this time he integrated the newly acquired Bayer sulfate process pigment plants, and later the ex-Kemira chloride process plant, into Kerr-McGee's global business.

From 1999 until 2002, David was chairman of the Titanium Dioxide Manufacturers' Association, a sector group of Cefic.

His specialist interests are the global market for TiO₂ pigment with a particular emphasis on Europe, the strategic development of the TiO₂ industry, and the sulfate process.

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
